

## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

**Job Title:** Production Sanitation Technician

**Department:** Production

**Reports to:** Production Team Lead & Production Supervisor

### **Summary of Position:**

The Production Sanitation Technician is responsible for all general cleaning and CIP in the production and processing areas. Functions include: rebuilding pumps and valves; washing tanks, lines and equipment by manual means and with the CIP system; foaming, scrubbing, and rinsing walls, ceilings, and floors; cleaning drains; maintaining sanitary entrances; following master sanitation guidelines; and completing required documentation within the specified timeline.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Daily cleaning of tanks, lines, and equipment in the production and processing areas using automated and manual means.
- Environmental cleaning of walls, ceilings, floors, and drains.
- Use of various mechanical cleaning devices (foamers, foggers, floor scrubbers, etc.)
- Rebuild pumps and valves as needed.
- Responsible for safety as it pertains to daily tasks; Equipment, PPE, GMPs, etc.
- Knowledge of chemicals and their uses
- Maintain doorway sanitizing systems
- Maintain organization and inventory of the chemical and cleaning supply rooms.
- Ensure completion & documentation of Master sanitation schedules.
- Maintain utensils (clean/autoclave)
- Check and calibrate temperature sensors and probes.
- Work with inventory department to complete physical inventory counts.
- Maintain SQF food safety and quality systems and report any concerns to Management.
- Assist other departments as directed by Supervisor

- Able to lift/carry up to 70 pounds repeatedly
- Ability to respond with a high sense of urgency
- Excellent time management
- Flexibility to work different schedules and overtime as needed
- Able to work in a standing position for extended periods of time
